- **Apply for SNAP Assistance** from your home computer or from your local library by going to the self-service portal at ssp.benefits.ohio.gov/apspspp/index.jsp. **You can also apply for Cash Assistance and Medicaid** at the self-service portal
- **The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)** serves families by providing nutrition education, supplemental foods, breastfeeding education & support, and referrals. WIC participation is based on income eligibility (185% of the federal poverty level) and nutrition risk. Pregnant women, new mothers, breastfeeding mothers, and infants and children up to age five are eligible. WIC is open on Monday – Thursday from 8:15 am to 3:00 pm and on Friday from 8:15 am to 11:00 am

- **FREE Nutrition Education Classes**
The OSU Extension in Montgomery County provides in-person and virtual nutrition education classes for adults and youth. - **The Seniors Farmers Market Nutrition Program** services low income seniors, age 60 and older, who are at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Line. Approved seniors will receive \$50 in coupons to spend on fresh fruits and vegetables. - **Senior Resource Connection** can coordinate nutritionally balanced home-delivered meals on a daily basis, Monday – Friday delivered between 10:30 AM and 2 PM. Generally, a person who is 60 years of age or older and unable to prepare their own meals on a regular basis, due to physical or neurological impairments, is eligible for the program.
